

CRITERIA FOR TENNESSEE EXTENSION MASTER GARDENER PROJECTS

Extension Master Gardener projects should always reflect the educational missions of the Tennessee Extension Master Gardener Program and Tennessee Extension. This is not a free labor program. Extension Master Gardener volunteers are talented and passionate educators, advisors, and helpers.

- Provide educational opportunities for Extension Master Gardeners and the public.
- Sanctioned beautification projects for churches and schools are not always recommended. Education may be offered while helping organizations in such projects.
- Create visibility for Master Gardeners (identified with Tennessee Extension Master Gardener sign).
- Be accessible to the public without admission fee.
- A project should benefit a city, county, state or nonprofit organization.
- Submitted on a Volunteer Project Request form.
- It is recommended that each new proposal be made available for committee reviews at least <u>one month</u> prior to starting date.
- Evaluations must be completed and turned in to the county Extension office.
